#### 1. Course Overview

Course: Planning and Scheduling Professional (PSP) Certification Preparation

Level: Practitioner

This course prepares candidates for AACE's PSP certification and develops competency in project planning, and developing, monitoring, updating, forecasting & analyzing integrated project schedules. A PSP is able to communicate effectively with all project stakeholders, both internal and external.

AACE's PSP certification distinguishes candidates as a professional that has the skills and knowledge that is benchmarked with international project planning and scheduling practices. A mock-up exam is included at the end of the pre-recorded online course.

The PSP certification was established in 2004 and is independently accredited by the Council of Engineering & Scientific Specialty Boards (CESB) since 2007. The course is based upon Skills and Knowledge for Cost Engineering 6<sup>th</sup> edition by AACE International.

**Eligibility requirements:** 4-year industry-related experience plus 4-year industry-related college degree or 8-years industry related experience.
